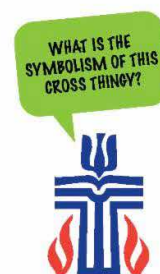
USHERS & GREETERS NEEDED - Please help out the Worship Committee by signing up to usher or greet. See the sign-up sheet in the Commons.

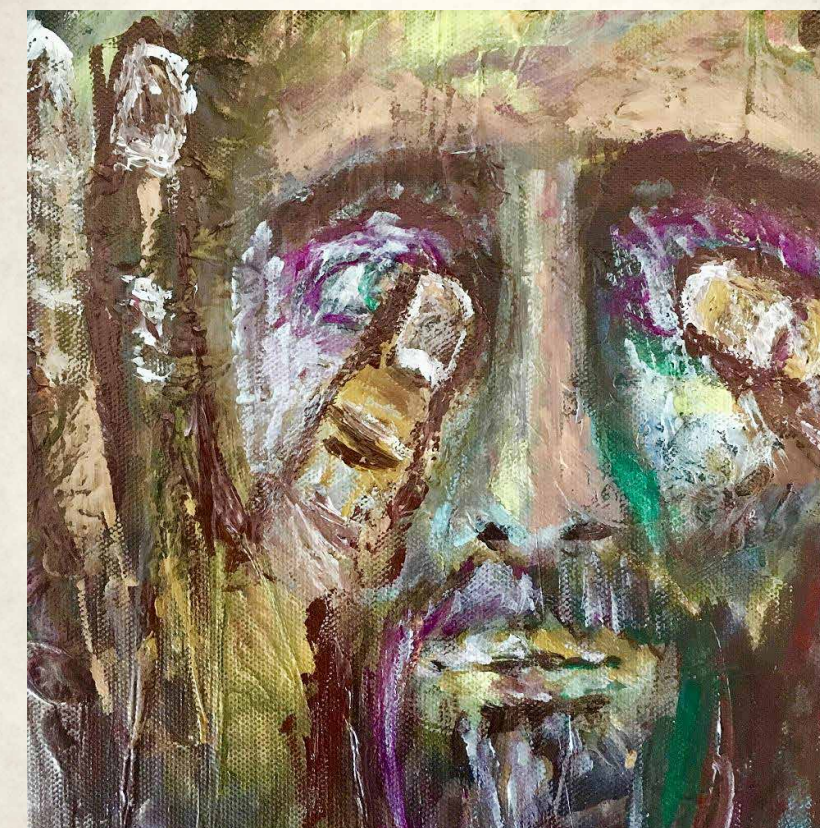

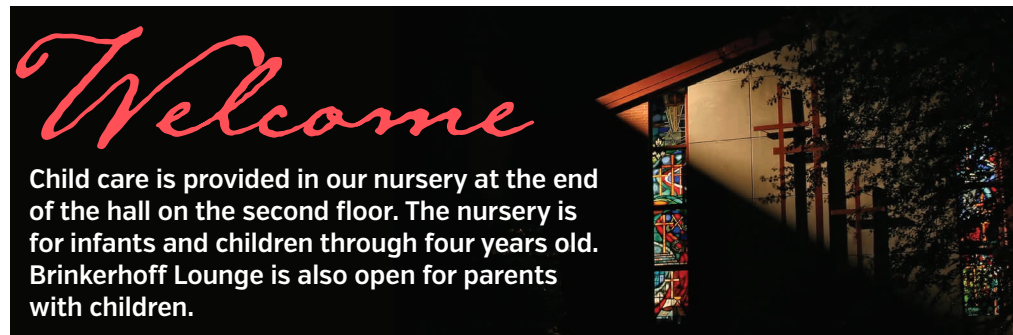

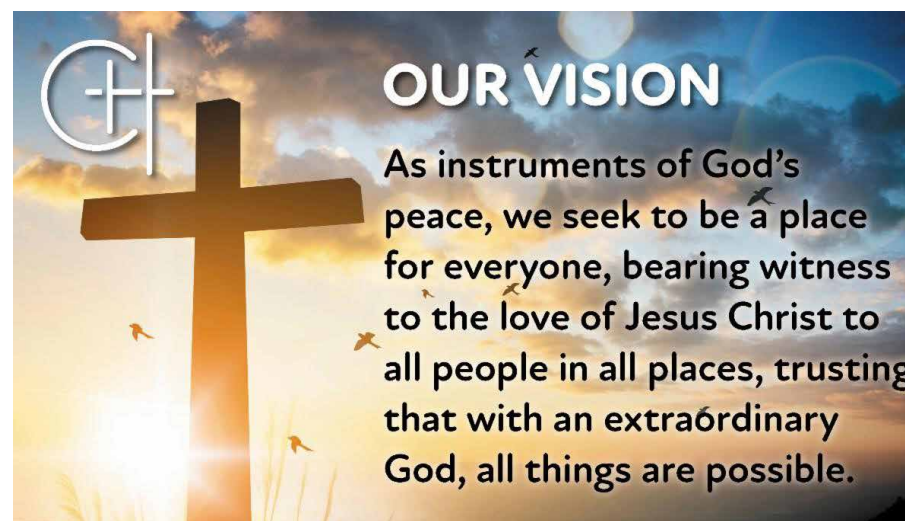
