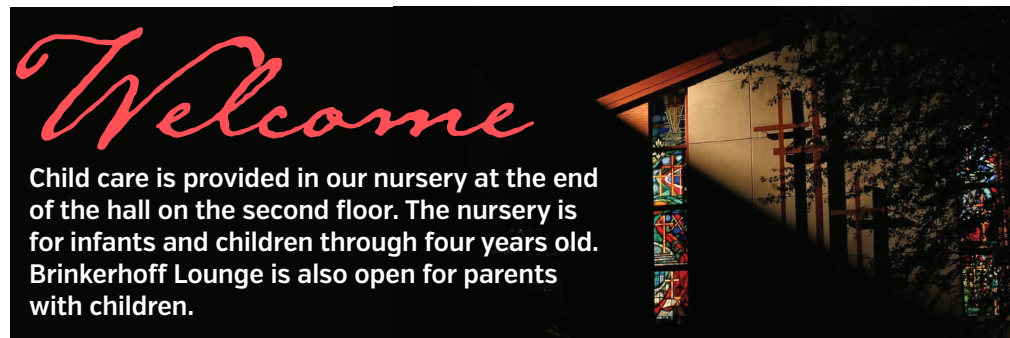

Solemn Reproaches of the Cross Rev. Christine Kaplunas
