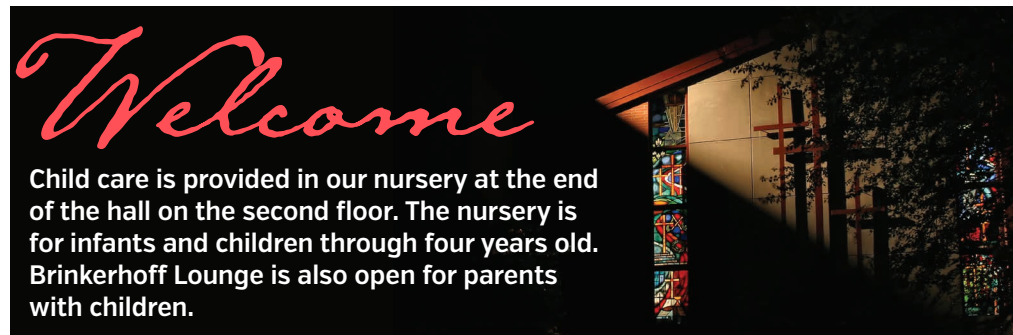

*Window II - This represents the ministry of Christ. First at the top of the window is the dove, which represents the Holy Spirit. This is the second symbol of the Presbyterian Church. Flowing down around the Chi-Rho past the crutch with the wing of an angel and the candle are seven flames representing the miracles of Christ, these seven flames represent the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit: Blessing, Glory, Wisdom, Thanksgiving, Honor, Power and Might. The crutch symbolizes the healing power of Christ. The candle symbolizes Christ the Light of the World.*
