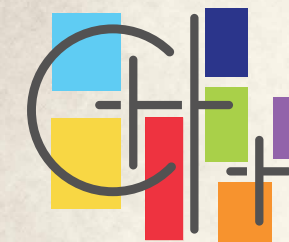

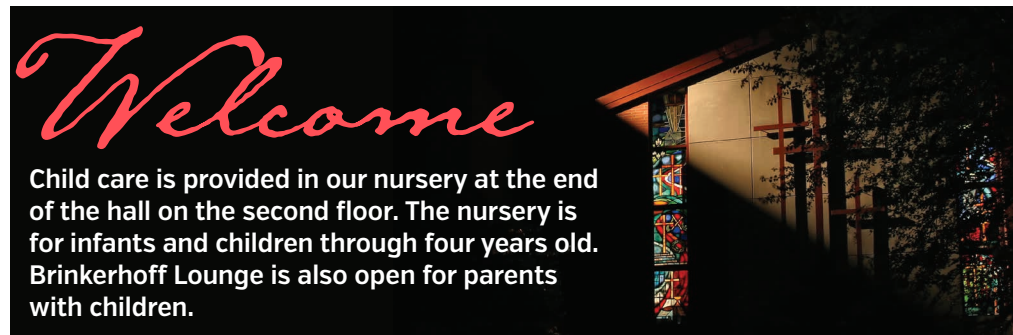

WINDOW VII - The Great Missionary Command. At the top is the hand of God and the eternal flames on each side. The flames symbolize the love of God as well as all the world's strength and power. The rays flow downward over the Bible, which is the other Presbyterian symbol, and represents the Word of God and is a reference to Christ based on Revelation 1:8. I am the Alpha and Omega, The Beginning and the End. The arrow is the symbol of Martyrdom. From the Bible the flow continues down and covers the world, thus symbolizing Matthew 28:18-20: "Go ye therefore, and teach all nations..."
