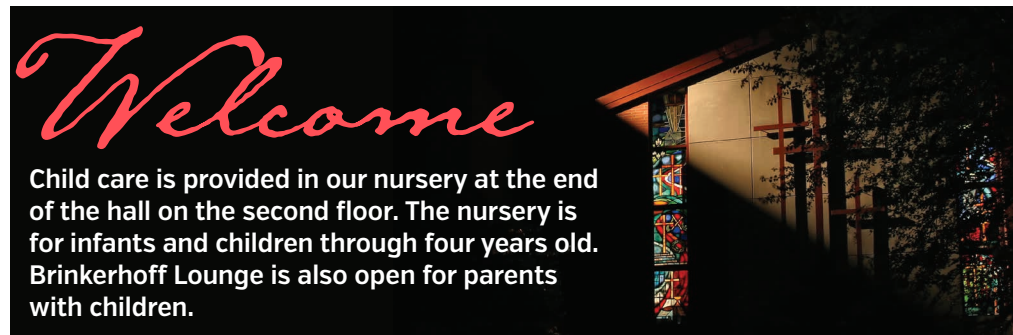

WINDOW V - Symbolizes the Graces of Christ and the sacraments. At the top of the window the Chalice and host with the Chi-Rho representing Christ. Rays, flowing up and out from the cup, represent the Holy Eucharist. Out of this cup flows the living water or the graces of the Church. These graces flow downward to the Holy Sacraments. The Holy Sacraments are represented by the cross which also symbolizes Christ. The flowing water, the green branches of olive leaves represent the inexhaustible stream of the Church's graces we receive like the fish within the water. Grace and strength for a holy life.
