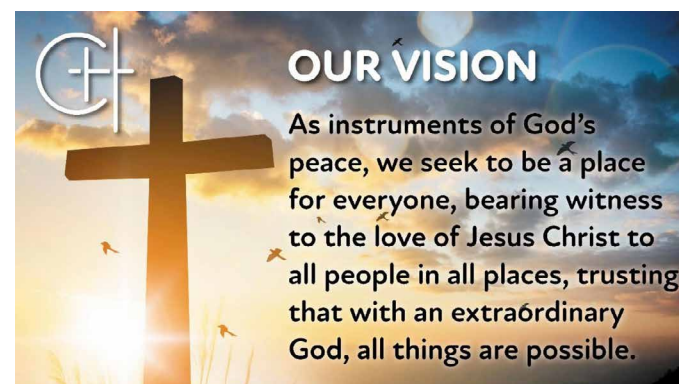
This group, while showing its "grey," welcomes all ages for intergenerational discussions and fellowship. We look forward to seeing you!

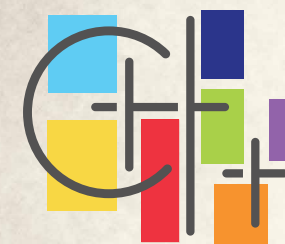

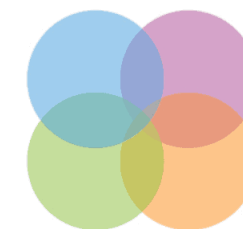
