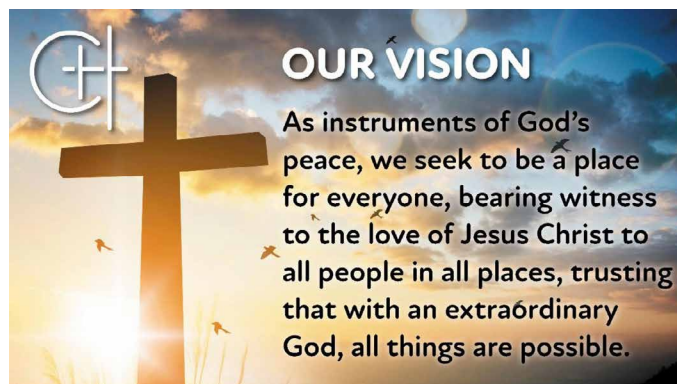
TODAY is the last Sunday for Sunday School and

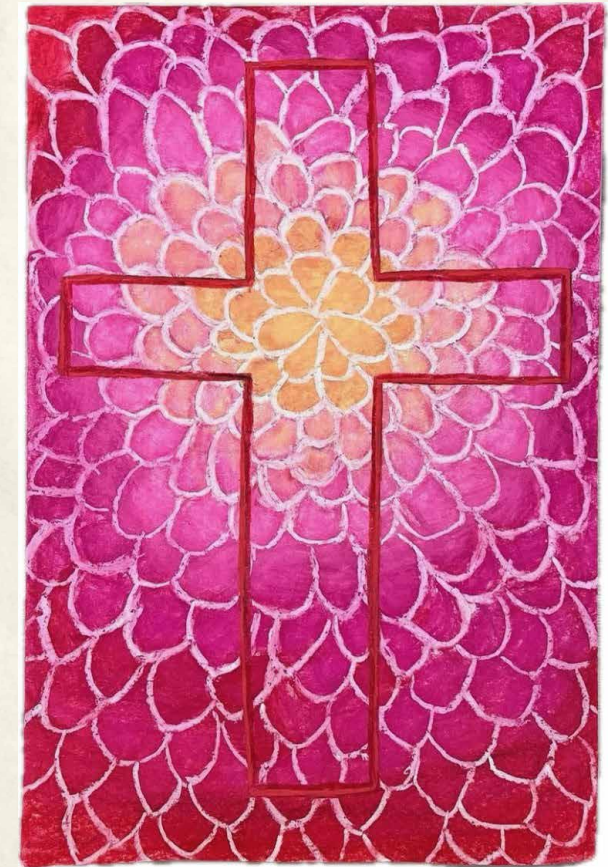
