He has completed his chemotherapy and is now recovering from its cumulative effects. He continues his work to the best of his ability with some adaptations. He will be keeping safe distances through his ongoing recovery. On Sunday mornings, Dave will remain in his office before and after worship and will limit his movement during the service to the pulpit area.
