PASTOR'S CHEMOTHERAPY & WORK PATTERNS: Pastor Dave has been diagnosed with testicular cancer, a highly curable type of cancer. His 4th of four cycles is done. He has completed his chemotherapy and is now recovering from its cumulative effects. He continues his work to the best of his ability with some adaptations. He will be keeping safe distances through his ongoing recovery. On Sunday mornings, Dave will remain in his office before and after worship and will limit his movement during the service to the pulpit area. Worshippers are encouraged to wear masks, esp. those who sit closer to the front. Thank you for your understanding, your patience and your prayers. "For everything there is a season ..." 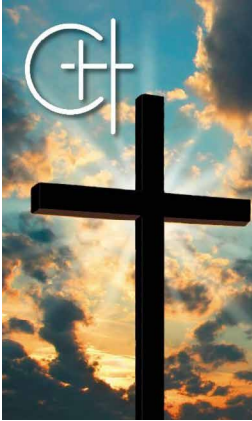
