PASTOR'S CHEMOTHERAPY & WORK PATTERNS: Pastor Dave has been diagnosed with testicular cancer, a highly curable type of cancer. His 4th of four cycles is done. He has completed his chemotherapy and is now recovering from its cumulative effects. He continues his work to the best of his ability with some adaptations. He will be keeping safe distances through his ongoing recovery. On Sunday mornings, Dave will remain in his office before and after worship and will limit his movement during the service to the pulpit area. Worshippers are encouraged to wear masks, esp. those who sit closer to the front. Thank you for your understanding, your patience and your prayers. "For everything there is a season ..." SUNDAY SUPPER SHELVES ARE FULL!! With our Easter Season food collection we have helped fill the pantry. We also received \$995 in cash donations. You are amazing! Thank you for supporting hunger relief. *Outreach Committee*

YOUR OUTREACH COMMITTEE has unanimously approved donating in June the remainder of the Mission Fund Balance in the General Fund of \$2,165.98 to the Northeast Iowa Food Bank. This money will be specifically designated to their new Capacity Campaign to increase the size of their facility. Those they serve have more than tripled since the building was built in 2013. The Sunday Supper program is a partner organization of the NEIFB.

WOMEN'S BOOK GROUP will meet **Thursday, June 12 at 9:30 a.m.** in Brinkerhoff. We will be discussing "James" by Percival Everett.

PLEASE JOIN US! We are planning an ecumenical service of repentance to be held on **Thursday, June 19 (Juneteenth) beginning at 6 p.m.** at First Presbyterian Church, Cedar Falls. The service will focus particularly on our sins of omission: those things we have left undone/unsaid. This will be a time for those most culpable of perpetuating injustice and racist systems [namely White Christians] to commit to repentance. The service will be preceded by a community meal of solidarity; namely, a time for us to prepare for worship, to reflect on the progress made, and [critically] the work ahead.
